<p><b><u>ABC&amp;123s</u></b>          Grades: 2/3K          Fall Semester. Hour 1          Class size: 10          Homework Level: 0  <b>Cost: \$5</b></p>	<p><b><i>Oldest child in family must be age 5 by September 1<sup>st</sup> and registered with option 1, option 2 or option 3.</i></b> This class will introduce foundational preschool learning to the tots of co-op. We will use songs, books, art, and games to teach these eager minds the alphabet, numbers and counting, shapes, colors, animals, and much more!</p>
<p><b><u>Circle Time</u></b>          Grades: 2/3K          Fall Semester. Hour 2          Class size: 10          Homework Level: 0  <b>Cost: \$5</b></p>	<p><b><i>Oldest child in family must be age 5 by September 1<sup>st</sup> and registered with option 1, option 2 or option 3.</i></b> Preschool skills and lessons taught in a fun and engaging way. Play and learning combine to create a circle time your tots will be excited to come to co-op for!</p>
<p><b><u>Sensory Fun</u></b>          Grades: 2/3K          Spring Semester. Hour 1          Class size: 10          Homework level: 0  <b>Cost: \$5</b></p>	<p><b><i>Oldest child in family must be age 5 by September 1<sup>st</sup> and registered with option 1, option 2 or option 3.</i></b> Learning through lessons that engage the senses. Sensory bins, gross motor games, and hands on activities reinforce preschool concepts for these early learners.</p>
<p><b><u>Friends &amp; Fine Motor</u></b>          Grades: 2/3K          Spring Semester. Hour 2          Class size: 10          Homework level: 0  <b>Cost: \$5</b></p>	<p><b><i>Oldest child in family must be age 5 by September 1<sup>st</sup> and registered with option 1, option 2 or option 3.</i></b> It's never too early to start developing the fine motor skills children need to be successful in the classroom. In this class students will develop these skills through fine motor activities. The benefits of this class will carry through their whole school career!</p>

Hour:2          Class Size: 10          Homework Level: 0  <b>Cost: \$10</b></p>	<p><b><i>Oldest child in family must be age 5 by September 1<sup>st</sup> and registered with option 1, option 2 or option 3.</i></b> Reading is the foundation of all learning! In this class, students will enjoy hearing exciting stories on various topics. Comprehension, art, music, and play will complete the fun.</p>

Using the Scientific Method, students will think through as we conduct various experiments each week.</p>
<p><b><u>Squish and Learn: Playdoh Creations</u></b>  Grades: 4K, 5K, 1st  Spring Semester. We will learn how to make many shapes, letters, numbers, and even our names! We will also get to see how colors mix together, and learn how to work together as a team to make story boards!</p>
<p><b><u>Little Bookworms 2</u></b>  Grades: 4K, 5k, 1st  Spring Semester. Hour:2  Class size:10  Homework level:0  <b>Cost: \$10</b></p>	<p><b><i>Oldest child in family must be age 5 by September 1<sup>st</sup> and registered with option 1, option 2 or option 3.</i></b> In the second semester of this class, the kids will continue to enjoy story time and engaging activities with a focus on “Christian’s Journey”.</p>
<p><b><u>Lab Rats Science 2</u></b>  Grades: 2nd-4th  Fall Semester Hour:1  Class Size: 10  Homework Level: 0  <b>Cost: \$15</b></p>	<p>Students will love investigating and discovering the wonders of God’s amazing world in this class. They will determine messages communicated by an image, and revise personal artwork on the basis of insight gained through peer discussion.</p>

Experiments, note booking assignments, narration, and a "personal person project" provide interaction with concepts outside of reading, and help to solidify understanding.</p>

They will develop research and critical thinking skills to construct and deliver effective arguments. They will implement offensive and defensive strategies to convince the widest possible audience.</p>
