This study of anatomy and physiology showcases the intricacy and design of the human body, from DNA and cell creation to the skeletal, muscular, digestive, respiratory, cardiovascular, nervous/endocrine, immune, and integumentary systems. Integrated with health and nutrition information, as well as plenty of scripture and biblical application. Experiments, note booking assignments, narration, and a "personal person project" provide interaction with concepts outside of reading, and help to solidify understanding.</p>
